

WAYS TO PRACTICE SIGHT WORDS

1. Make flash cards using the template provided by your teacher.
2. Hang up two sight words across the room and race your child to read the word in "your lane".
3. Go on a Sight Word Scavenger Hunt by hiding flashcards around the house. The person who finds and reads the most, wins!
4. Create a word search puzzle on www.puzzlemaker.com.
5. Hang the words on the ceiling (*or on a wall across the room*). Then, turn the lights off and use a flashlight to highlight/read the words.
6. Make the words out of Play Doh.
7. Make two sets of cards and play "Memory".
(Place cards face down. Take turns flipping cards over to make a match. Player with the most matches at the end of the game wins.)
8. Make four sets of cards and play "Sight Word War". (Both players flip over a card, first to read their card, wins both cards.)
9. Make a BINGO board with your sight words and use a set of cards as the calling cards.
10. Play Go Fish, using a few sets of cards.
11. Play "Sight Word Tic-Tac-Toe". (Fill a board with nine of your trickiest sight words. When it is your turn, you must correctly read the sight word in your desired box in order to "earn" the chance to place your "X" or "O".)
12. "Rainbow Write" your sight words. (Write your word entirely in red crayon first. Then, trace over it with orange, then yellow, green, blue, and purple. When you are finished, you will have written each word 6 times...and it will be beautiful too! ☺)
