Parental Request to “Opt Out” of Release of Student Information to Military Recruiters, College/University Recruiters Prospective Employers, and/or Local County Vocational School

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Under the federal “No Child Left Behind” Act, public high schools must give the names, addresses and telephone numbers of students to military recruiters, college/university recruiters and prospective employers if the recruiters request the information (P.L. 107-110, Section 9528; 10 USC 503). New Jersey middle schools and high schools must also provide this contact information to the local county vocational school. Students or their parents, however, have the right to instruct the school in writing that this information is not to be released.

If you do not consent to the release of this information to 1) military recruiters, 2) colleges/university recruiters, 3) prospective employers, and/or 4) the local county vocational school, please check the appropriate box or boxes below. To be certain your wishes are respected, return this form to the Main Office of your child’s school by September 30th. Signed forms returned after that date will be effective after receipt by the appropriate Main Office:

- DO NOT release student contact information to Military Recruiters.
- DO NOT release student contact information to College/University Recruiters.
- DO NOT release student contact information to prospective employers.
- DO NOT release student contact information to the Gloucester Country Institute of Technology.

*** Students have the right to request that their contact information not be released to recruiters. Parents can override a child’s decision by notifying the school in writing, only if the student is under age 18. We encourage parents and students to discuss this information.
