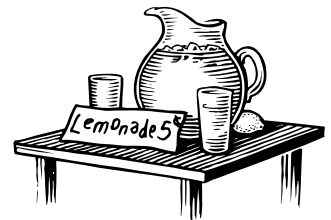

## Express Checkout



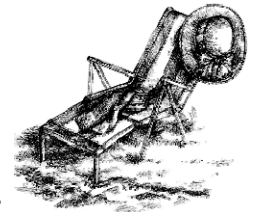
We will use Express Checkout at the end of the year. If you don't owe anything to the IMC, you don't have to stop in to get your paper signed, although we would love see you.

We will email a form around June 5th that says everything has been returned to the IMC, and you can attach that to your obligation form.

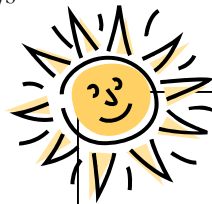
